

SOLO VALCOUR

DATE: Saturday, August 18, 2012

Start at 11: 00 a.m.

WHERE: BLUFF POINT, VALCOUR ISLAND South or North

On the beach, leeward side.

COURSE: A distance of approximately 12 miles starting from the green

can at BLUFF POINT in a Northerly or Southerly direction

depending on the wind.

CHALLENGE: All manœuvres must be done solo. You can use an

autopilot if you have one. You can have passengers on

board that can assist you until 5 minutes before the start.

After that, your passengers must remain in the cockpit. No

hiking or counter hiking from passengers is allowed.

START: There will be only one boat at the time on the starting line.

YOUR START TIME: Start time will be based on your handicap. For example, the

slowest boat will start at 11:00 a.m. The second boat's start

time will be based on the 'time on distance' calculation. The starting line cannot be crossed until your allotted start time. The comity boat will advise a boat of a false start with a red flag. The said boat must then come back below the start line and re-cross it.

STARTING SEQUENCE:

- 10 minutes before 11:00 a.m..: White flag raised.
- 6 minutes before the start: White flag removed.
- 5 minutes the start: Blue flag raised.
- Start: Blue flag removed and one long horn.

INTERDICTIONS:

The use of the following are not permitted:

- spinnaker;
- code zero ;
- whisker poles;
- gaff hooks.

The use of two sails only is permitted.

COMMUNICATIONS:

VHF Channel #6 if required.

RESULTS:

They are based on your true elapsed time calculated from your start time to arrival at finish line and then adjusted based on the « time on time » method. Hence, your official position can be different than your position on the water.

RESULTS:

On the beach, around 4:00 p.m. BYOB & drinks.
